

North Oaks Dietetic Internship

Graduation Requirements

Graduation from North Oaks Medical Center Dietetic Internship requires satisfactory completion of a minimum of 1,211 hours of supervised practice as scheduled and provided. The intern will receive written notification of progress toward completion of requirements throughout the year in the form of written evaluations. The intern will receive a Verification Statement that verifies the individual indicated has completed the requirements of the specific dietetics approved program.

Sites for supervised practice are planned to include North Oaks Medical Center, North Oaks Rehabilitation Hospital, Office of Public Health, Lallie Kemp Medical Center, Davita Dialysis Units, St. Tammany Child Nutrition Program, Post-Acute Specialty Hospital of Hammond, Lion's Club Diabetes Camp, Northlake Surgical Associates, Louisiana Department of Health, and STPH Wellness Center.

There are also supervised practice/lecture affiliations with the Southeast District Dietetic Association and the Louisiana Dietetic Association.

General Information

Dietetic Internship activities will be scheduled at a minimum of 24 hours per week. This is a part-time program making part-time employment possible. There is no full-time option.

Interns must have access to a reliable car for transportation to various sites of Dietetic Internship activities. Mass transit sufficient to meet the intern's needs is unavailable.

Interns who are employed outside of the Dietetic Internship will be expected to inform the Program Director of the requirements of their job in terms of scheduling. The intern is encouraged to be as flexible as possible concerning working hours. All efforts will be made to meet the intern's needs for employment, but the Dietetic Internship requirements will take priority in decisions made by the Dietetic Internship Director if the intern's work situation is in conflict with Dietetic Internship requirements.
