PROGRAM EFFECTIVENESS DATA

The radiography program reports the following data to JRCERT.

Completion Rate – this is the number of students that began the program divided by the number completing the program.

Credentialing Exam Pass Rate – this is the number of students that pass the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) certification examination on the first attempt within 6 months of graduation.

Job Placement Rate: 2012 – 2016
