Sputum Collection

Specimen drop offs are accepted at:

North Oaks Diagnostic Center: Monday – Friday from 7 am – 5 pm

North Oaks-Livingston Parish Medical Complex: Monday – Friday from 7 am – 3 pm

The container given to you is sterile and should not be opened until ready to use.

Do not touch the rim of the container.

Sputum specimens should be collected when you first wake before smoking, eating or drinking.

Instructions:

- 1. Rinse (do not swallow) with water before sputum is collected to minimize mouth bacteria or food particles that may contaminate the specimen. Do not use mouthwash.
- 2. Wash your hands with soap and water. Dry thoroughly.
- 3 Remove the lid of the container and set aside.
- 4. Take several deep breaths.
- 5 Cough hard from deep inside the chest three times to bring sputum up from your lungs.
- 6. Spit the sputum into the provided container carefully. Do not spit saliva or postnasal discharge into the container.
- 7. Repeat until you have 1 tablespoon of sputum in the container.
- 8. Replace the cap tightly on the plastic container.
- 9. If necessary, wash and dry the outside of the container.
- 10. Write your name, date of birth, time and date of collection on the container label and place it into the plastic biohazard bag provided.
- 11. If you are unable to return your specimen within 2 hours of collection, place into the refrigerator. Your specimen is stable at room temperature for 2 hours and refrigerated for 24 hours.
